

Longwave Loggings Template

About the Table:

Enter your loggings by typing directly into each table cell. The first two rows are sample entries only, and may be erased or overwritten. You can move from cell to cell by pressing the Tab key or just clicking in a cell. To add more rows, simply press the Tab key at the end of the last row of the table.

Entry Notes:

FRQ: Frequency in kHz. Please list your loggings from the lowest frequency to highest.

ID: Station identifier. If you are unsure of the ID for a station, you can place a question mark beside it (e.g., CLB?) and I will attempt to verify it for you. If there is no ID, such as for an unknown carrier, pulse, or other mystery signal, simply place "UNID" in this column (to denote "unidentified"). Please avoid submitting a large number of unidentified stations. There are resources available for you to determine this information, such as the World Aeronautical Database at: <http://worldaerodata.com/>.

ST/PR/ITU: This column is for entering the U.S. State, Canadian Province or ITU country code of the station received. A list of ITU codes may be obtained from the following website: http://www.wordiq.com/definition/ITU_letter_codes

CITY: Please list the properly spelled name of the city for each logging. (If the location is not known, simply place "Unknown" here.)

Date/Time: Date in month/day format (e.g., 6/7), followed by standard 4-digit UTC time as broadcast by WWV or CHU radio.

BY: This column consists of the logger's initials (with periods), followed by the State (or Province) in parentheses. Please use this same format for each log entry.

Each time you submit your loggings, please fill out the information at the top of the form so that I can properly credit your contributions or contact you for clarification, if needed: Name, Ham call (if any), E-Mail Address, Your city of reception, Receiver(s) used, Antenna(s) used. Any additional comments are also welcome.
